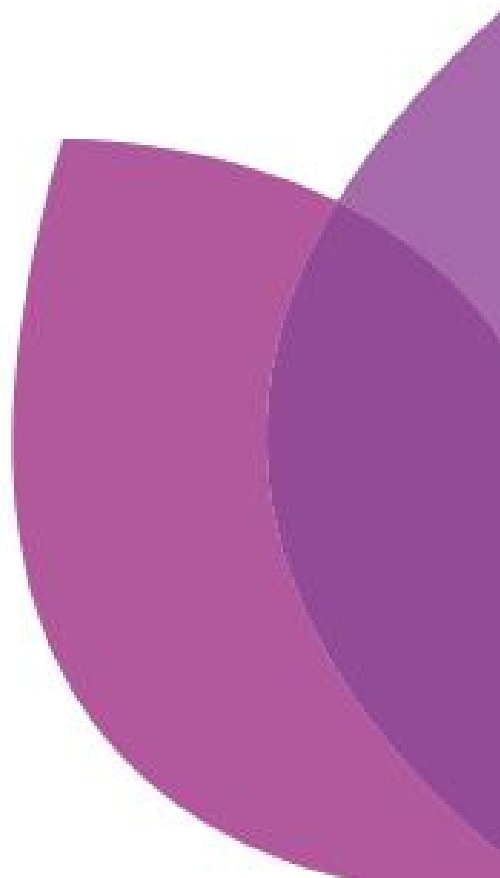

# Using essential oils for the treatment or prevention of disease

Aromatherapy is the use of plant extracts known as essential oils for the treatment or prevention of disease, designed to treat the whole person helping the body to achieve balance and good health.

Essential oils are readily absorbed via the skin and olfactory system. Their therapeutic constituents are carried around the body where they can deliver their beneficial healing effects. Essential oils combined with specific massage techniques make for an amazing massage experience.

# Re-tune and balance the body's energy through the feet

Reflexology is a theory and therapy that uses the feet as a map or mirror of the whole body. By manipulating and applying pressure to certain areas of the feet the body can be re-tuned and brought back into balance.

This intensive course focuses on practical skills and underpinning knowledge required in the complementary therapies industry and is designed for Learners who want to work as a reflexologist in a complementary therapy setting or for those working within the spa or beauty industry. It is acceptable for registration on the CNHC register.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

None. There is no requirement of a massage or anatomy and physiology qualification.

## COURSE DURATION

8 days spread over 8 weeks. Additional home study is required for projects, portfolio evidence, research and revision.

## COURSE CONTENT INCLUDES:

- Reflexology treatments for the feet and hands for complementary therapies
- A variety of massage techniques for reflex zones of the feet and hands
- Anatomy, physiology and pathology for complementary therapies
- Client care and communications as a complementary practitioner
- Principles and practice of complementary therapies
- Business practice for complementary therapies.





Massage therapy can be learnt as a stand-alone career or a starting point for learning holistic therapies such as reflexology, aromatherapy, Indian head massage and so much more.

Designed for complete beginners to massage; this intensive and thorough course focuses on a range of practical skills and theoretical knowledge, including anatomy and physiology required to perform massage to a professional standard.

This course is a qualification that has been specifically designed to give students knowledge and understanding of the main systems of the body.

No prior knowledge or qualifications necessary.

This is a stand-alone qualification that requires a good proportion of home-study. Specifically it will provide a platform for Learners to go on to further study in beauty, massage and holistic therapies.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

None.

## DURATION

16 hours tuition spread over several weeks with additional home study for projects, portfolio evidence, research and revision.

## COURSE CONTENT INCLUDES:

- Anatomical and physiological knowledge of body systems:
  - Skeletal system
  - Muscular system
  - Nervous system
  - Endocrine system
  - Respiratory system

# Enhance your treatment menu with this wonderful and popular treatment

This course is a vocational qualification that will enhance your skills as a massage therapist.

Stone therapy massage uses specialist stones of varying temperatures to massage the face and body.

Combined with Swedish massage techniques the hot stones provide deep heat therapy and relaxation whilst cold stones are used for stimulating circulation.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Level 3 massage qualification required.

## DURATION

3 days including 1 assessment day.

Additional home study is required for portfolio evidence, research and revision.

## COURSE CONTENT INCLUDES:

- Consultation techniques
- Physical and psychological effects of massage
- Use and application of hot and cold stones within a full body massage
- Contra-indications and contra-actions



## AWARD IN THERMAL AURICULAR THERAPY - LEVEL 2

Also known as ear candling, this is an intensive and thorough course for qualified massage therapists. It focuses on a range of practical skills and underpinning theoretical knowledge required to perform Thermal Auricular Therapy to a professional standard.

### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Level 2 beauty therapy or specialist or Level 3 body massage qualification or equivalent required.

### COURSE DURATION

1 day plus 1 assessment day if taking the optional VTCT qualification. Additional home study may be required for portfolio evidence, research and revision.



### COURSE CONTENT INCLUDES:

- The benefits and contraindications of thermal auricular therapy
- Massage techniques for the head and neck
- Anatomy and physiology related to thermal auricular therapy
- Client care and communications as a complementary practitioner
- Reflective practice and business skills

## AWARD IN INDIAN HEAD MASSAGE - LEVEL 3

This is an intensive and thorough course for qualified massage therapists. It focuses on a range of practical skills and theoretical knowledge required to perform Indian head massage to a professional standard. A very popular treatment and is an asset to any treatment menu.

### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Level 3 massage qualification required.

### COURSE DURATION

2 days plus 1 assessment day. Additional home study is required for portfolio evidence, research and revision.

### COURSE CONTENT INCLUDES:

- The benefits and contraindications of Indian head massage
- A variety of massage techniques for Indian head massage
- Client care and communications as a complementary practitioner
- Reflective practice and business skills



# Support a team, provide guidance and learn leadership skills

This course will enable you to gain the essential practical and theoretical skills to manage a spa or salon environment professionally and effectively. Giving a better understanding of how to support a team of staff, provide guidance and learn leadership skills. Students can join this course without prior qualifications within the beauty industry, however it is also a great option for qualified therapists or nail technicians who wish to further their career and progress into management.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

None, although some experience in the beauty sector would be an advantage.

## COURSE DURATION

10 days spread over 5 months. Additional home study is required for portfolio evidence, research and revision.

## COURSE CONTENT INCLUDES:

- Monitoring and maintenance of the spa area; steam, sauna, hydrotherapy, showers, relaxation areas
- Salon design for hair and beauty sector
- Salon management; staff, customers, employers
- Management of health, safety and security for the beauty business
- Contributing to the effective running of a business

- Marketing and PR for the hair and beauty sector
- Commercialism and professionalism



## CERTIFICATE IN LASER AND LIGHT TREATMENTS - LEVEL 4

Designed for beginners and experienced practitioners to broaden experience and knowledge whilst gaining a recognised qualification; to align with industry standards and insurance recommendations.

This course covers manufacturer training, Core of Knowledge and the full range of Laser Light and IPL hair removal and skin rejuvenation treatments.

Due to the nature of the treatments learnt it can be an advantage to have prior knowledge of the anatomy and physiology of skin and hair.



### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

5 GCSEs grades A to C or equivalent or a Level 2 diploma for beauty specialist or nursing degree. Exemptions may be made for adult returners with experience in the work place.

### DURATION

5 days spread over one week. Additional home study is required for portfolio evidence and revision.

### COURSE CONTENT INCLUDES:

- Core of knowledge
- Manufacturer training for Laser and IPL: Hair removal, skin rejuvenation including red veins, pigmentation, anti-ageing and scarring, acne and rosacea
- Anatomy, physiology, science and cosmetology related to each treatment
- Client care and communication in the beauty related industries
- Management of health and safety and security in the salon

## DIPLOMA IN PERMANENT HAIR REDUCTION AND SKIN REJUVENATION - LEVEL 4

Suitable for beginners and experienced practitioners to align with industry standards and insurance recommendations.

This course covers manufacturer training, Core of Knowledge, a full range of Laser Light and IPL hair removal and skin rejuvenation treatments, epilation, advanced epilation and micro dermabrasion.

It can be an advantage to have prior knowledge of the anatomy and physiology of skin and hair.



### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

5 GCSEs grades A to C or equivalent or a Level 2 diploma for beauty specialist or nursing degree.

### DURATION

12 days spread over 3 months. Additional home study is required for portfolio evidence and revision.

### COURSE CONTENT INCLUDES:

- Core of knowledge
- Manufacturer training for Laser and IPL: Hair removal, skin rejuvenation including red veins, pigmentation, anti-ageing and scarring, acne and rosacea
- Epilation
- Advanced Epilation
- Micro Dermabrasion
- Anatomy, physiology, science and cosmetology related to each treatment
- Management of health and safety and security in the salon
- Physiology of ageing

## DIPLOMA IN NAIL TECHNOLOGY - LEVEL 3

This course teaches a full range of hand and foot treatments using various systems; liquid and powder, gel or wraps.

Designed to industry standards aligned with the National Occupational Standards, IBHA deliver over and above the required curriculum to enable students to work to a commercial standard whether employed self-employed. Students can go on to further study in the beauty sector.

### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

None.

### COURSE DURATION

20 days spread over 6 months. Additional home study is required for portfolio evidence, research and revision.



### COURSE CONTENT INCLUDES:

- Manicure and pedicure from basic to advanced treatments including varnish application
- Applying and the maintenance of nail enhancements or extensions
- Nail Art application
- E-filing
- Display
- Promotion of products
- Anatomy and physiology related to treatments
- Health and safety practice in the salon
- Exceptional standards on client care and communications
- Commercialism and professionalism working in the beauty related industries

## AWARD IN GEL POLISH TECHNIQUES - LEVEL 2

This course is suitable for those with a manicure qualification and will teach both practical and theoretical skills needed to perform this treatment on family and friends or even as a professional nail technician.

During the course students will have the opportunity to test your skills on clients and learn hints and tips on how to apply gel polish without lifting, chipping or cracking.

### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

No prior knowledge required.

### COURSE DURATION

One day plus optional assessment day.



### COURSE CONTENT INCLUDES:

- Detailed nail and skin analysis, contra-indications
- Consultation techniques
- Tools and product knowledge
- Apply light cured gel polish
- Light curing equipment
- Removal of gel polish

## CERTIFICATE IN EPILATION - LEVEL 3

Become a qualified electrologist. Electrolysis is a traditional method of hair removal that is still as popular in salons today as it was 30 years ago.

After completing this course, you will be able to provide electrolysis as a standalone treatment or as a compliment to the beauty specialist qualification.

Short wave diathermy and blend methods are taught in this course.

### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

5 GCSEs grades A to C or equivalent. However, exemptions may be made for adult returners with experience in the work place. Or Level 2 beauty specialist or equivalent.

### COURSE DURATION

3 days. Additional home study is required for portfolio evidence, research and revision.



### COURSE CONTENT INCLUDES:

- The benefits and contraindications of electrolysis
- Shortwave diathermy and blend methods of electrolysis
- Practical and theory knowledge over and above the required standards
- Anatomy and physiology related to treatments
- Commercialism and professionalism
- Exceptional standards on client care and communications

## AWARD IN SKIN BLEMISH REMOVAL - LEVEL 4

This course is a vocationally related qualification focused on carrying out advanced electrical epilation techniques to treat skin tags, milia, telangiectasia, spider naevi and blood spots.

Students will learn advanced skills needed to carry out a thorough consultation, formulate an individual treatment plan and provide aftercare advice. Health, safety and hygiene are also key elements of this qualification.

### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Level 3 certificate in electrical epilation required.

### COURSE DURATION

2 days.



### COURSE CONTENT INCLUDES:

- Communicate and behave in a professional manner
- Follow health and safety working practices
- Position yourself and the client correctly throughout the treatment
- Use products, tools and equipment to suit client treatment needs
- Adapt the advanced epilation techniques to suit client needs and skin conditions
- Complete the treatment to the satisfaction of the client
- Record and evaluate the results of the treatment
- Provide suitable aftercare advice



# Advanced technology for results driven facial treatments

This course will equip Learners with the knowledge and skills required to provide a range of electrical beauty treatments to complement the beauty specialist qualification.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Level 2 beauty specialist qualification required.

## COURSE DURATION

12 days spread over several weeks, plus additional home study for projects, portfolio evidence, research and revision.

## COURSE CONTENT INCLUDES:

- Benefits and contraindications of the specified facial treatments; galvanic, high frequency, micro-current, vacuum suction, faradic and micro-dermabrasion
- Practical and theory knowledge over and above the required standards
- Anatomy and physiology related to treatments
- Cosmetic science related to treatments
- Commercialism and professionalism
- Exceptional standards of client care and communication



Learn how to apply eyelash extensions involving the use of single eyelashes, including application, maintenance and removal along with suitable aftercare advice for clients.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Level 2 beauty specialist qualification required.

## COURSE DURATION

1 day introduction followed by 1 day assessment.

## COURSE CONTENT INCLUDES:

- Application of individual lash extensions
- Maintenance of individual lash extensions/infills
- Hygiene, health and safety
- Consultation
- Client care, homecare and maintenance advice



# Become a qualified assessor

This qualification provides a sound platform for learners wishing to progress to a practical assessor's qualification that is required for teaching and training in Further Education, private training establishments and work places with apprenticeship schemes.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Commercial experience and qualifications in your chosen profession. Students must be at least 19 years of age.

## COURSE DURATION

2 days with additional home study for projects, portfolio evidence and research.



## COURSE CONTENT INCLUDES:

- Principles and requirements of assessment
- Different types of assessment methods
- How to plan assessments
- How to involve learners and others in assessment
- How to make assessment decisions
- Quality assurance of the assessment process
- How to manage information relating to assessment
- Legal and good practice requirements in relation to assessment

This course will enable students to gain the necessary practical and theoretical skills in order to provide intimate waxing using hot wax systems for female clients and is a progression from standard waxing techniques.
